In consideration for certification as a Refuse To Be A Victim® instructor, the undersigned hereby agrees:

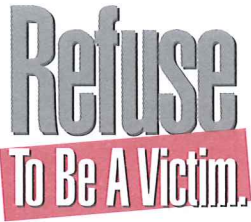
